This letter invites interested regulated parties to an EPA workshop to discuss certification, compliance, and implementation issues related to EPA's compliance program for Light-Duty Vehicles, Spark-Ignition Engines and Equipment, and Compression Ignition Engines and Vehicles.

The three-day workshop will be held on Tuesday, May 14, Wednesday May, 15, and Thursday, May 16, 2013 at the Courtyard Marriott in Ann Arbor, MI and will begin each day at 10:30am. The workshop will focus on EPA's certification policies, upcoming program requirements, compliance testing, and compliance reporting and will cover all mobile source sectors. All companies that certify or plan to certify vehicles, engines, components or equipment are encouraged to attend.

The Tuesday session will be devoted to Light-Duty Vehicle topics. The Wednesday session will be devoted to Gasoline Engine Sector issues including engine, equipment, and component supplier topics. The Thursday session will be devoted to Diesel Engine Sector issues including engine, equipment, and vehicle topics.
